It seems like we have been down this road before. Would the head of the Elections Department care to explain this?



Dallas County GOP chair defends Stefani Carter

Dallas County Republican Party Chairman Jonathan Neerman today strongly defended House District 102 candidate Stefani Carter against <u>charges</u> by Democrats that she plagiarized Barack Obama's famed, 2004 DNC convention speech and padded her resume.

After viewing a Long Star Project report on the matter, Neerman called the allegations petty.

"This is small ball," he said. "Stefani Carter is a great candidate and she's going to make a solid state representative."

Neerman said he was offended by portions of the Lone Star Project report that blasting Carter for "resume padding."

Carter was awarded the Lawrence Wade Journalism Fellowship, which the report pointed out is a 10-week internship with a \$1,000 stipend "for which minority students are given preference."

Neerman said that Democrats were suggesting that Carter got the internship because she was black. He singled out strategists Matt Angle and Jane Hamilton, both leaders in the Texas Democratic Trust.

"The implication that somehow this was a race-based internship and but for her race, she wouldn't have gotten it," Neerman said. "For Matt Angle, Jane Hamilton and the Lone Star Project to make the suggestion is wrong. If it was done intentionally, then it's despicable."

Hamilton unloaded on Neerman.

"What's wrong is that he's trying to play the race card and use it as a distraction and we're simply discussing the facts," said Hamilton, the North Texas director of the Democratic Trust. "Stefani Carter needs to honest with voters.

Angle operates the Lone Star Project, an outfit that pushes Democratic Party causes.

He said Neerman was missing the point and that Carter was misleading voters into believing that she was a prestigious Heritage Foundation fellow.

Democrats have also criticized Carter for stating in her biography that she's a columnist for *USA Today*. On an application to Gov. Rick Perry for a state board or commission appointment, Carter listed her employer as *USA Today*. Though she has written commentary for the newspaper, she is not listed as an employee or on their board of editorial contributors. An editor at *USA Today* confirmed that Carter wrote freelance commentary for the paper.

The war of words between Neerman and Democrats started after Angle mocked Carter for a speech she gave that was <u>simliar</u> to Obama's famed, keynote address at the 2004 National Democratic Convention.

"Jonathan Neerman needs to stop making empty excuses for a candidate he forgot to tell to be honest," Angle said. "He's got a candidate who is badly flawed and he needs to straighten her out and teach her not to plagiarize other speeches."

Carter, who described the speech as a talk, said Thursday that Democrats were "clearly attacking me" and that the "whole things was insulting." She has degrees from the University of Texas, the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard and the Harvard University Law School.

"We should be discussing Carol Kent's voting record and the issues of the district," Carter said.

Concerning the speech, Carter said she would not apologize for her life story and background. "No party has a copyright on the American dream," she said.

As for the claim to be a Heritage Fellow, Carter said she was Lawrence Wade Journalism "Fellow" at the foundation.

"What does Carol Kent think I did at the Heritage Foundation?" Carter asked. "Did she think I was a janitor?"

Kent beat Republican Tony Goolsby in 2008 to win the District 102 seat for Democrats. The district is still considered a battleground and Republicans hope their base numbers are high enough to flip it back to the red column.

Kent's campaign doesn't think that will happen.

"Clearly, this episode raises serious questions about Ms. Carter's preparedness and temperament to serve in the Legislature," said Kent campaign manager Phil Lovegren." There will be plenty of time to debate this issue and others during the fall campaign."






